Product information silver items



Every single item is checked after each stage. Small unevennesses regarding the form, surface or other details happen during the manual production and make every single item unique.

Silver tarnishes in the course of time. This is a reaction with sulphur in the air. Depending on the environmental pollution, the sulphur content is higher or lower so that you cannot say in general when an article will tarnish. The tarnishing of the items can permanently be avoided by lacquer-coating the items with a transparent Zappon lacquer which is finally burned in. This lacquer is very sensitive and can lose its protection e.g. when there is a scratch on it.

Starting from the scratch, the item can then tarnish under the complete lacquer-coating. Therefore, mainly decorative articles like photo frames or candleholders are lacquer-coated.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR SILVERED ITEMS WITHOUT LACQUER COATING

We recommend our special Fink CARE silver care range. Silvered items that are to be used for food (but also other silvered articles) are not lacquer-coated.

After a certain time, the silver reacts with sulfur in the air so that a silvered item which is not lacquer-coated tarnishes.

Tarnished articles can be polished again with a special silver care.
